

Council Work Session Minutes

Mayor Calvin Woodrey called to order @ 6:31pm. He turned the meeting over to City Manager Marcos Nichols. He asked that Rob Leichman Service Director. He discussed the two ordinances he has on the agenda for this evening. He explained the ordinance that would create a part time position for an administrative assistant for Public works. Tonight will be the second reading. Next he explained the ordinance that would amend section 1040.08 of the codified ordinances pertaining to sewage and waste. The EPA has asked that our Ordinance match that of the County due to that being where our waste is taken. He asked that the rules be suspended on this ordinance and be considered for passage this evening.

Next Finance Director Mike Engel discussed the final reading of the purchasing card policy ordinance. He explained this ordinance included some very minor changes to the policy that is already in place. This is up for a third reading. He then asked if the Admin committee would be able to meet on January 21st, 2021 at 5:30pm. All those that served on this committee agreed to meet. Councilwoman Harris asked if we were tapping into the available County funds for the business relief program because we had exhausted our funds for this. Mr. Engel stated yes we had exhausted our funds but we are able to tap into more funds from the County to continue to help our local businesses.

City Manager Marcos Nichols then asked for an executive session. Vice Mayor Perry made a motion to go into executive session to consider confidential information related to marketing plans, specific business strategy, production techniques, trade secrets, or personal financial statements of an applicant for economic development assistance, followed by a second by Councilwoman Harris. Roll call was taken; 7 ayes, 0 nays, 0 absent. Council went into executive session at 6:50pm. A motion for Council to come out of executive session and adjourn the Council work session was made by Vice Mayor Perry, followed by a second by Councilwoman Harris.
