



City Council Work Session Minutes May 19th, 2022

Mayor Calvin Woodrey called the Council Work session to order at 6:30pm. Mayor Woodrey asked that City Manager Marcos Nichols asked that City Treasurer, Matthew Mesisklis discuss the motion, he explained that it was a Then and Now, due to the fact that the item was received prior to a purchase order was made and that the proper process to keep us in compliance with the auditor's was for the Then and Now to be done.

Councilwoman Harris asked for a quick update on the situation with the playground equipment. City Manager Marcos Nichols explained that although the playground was opened in time for the Springfest, it was necessary that some repairs be made to the pour in place foundation for the playground needed to be made but it is not a big issue as just the spots that did not take quite right will be cut out and repaired. Also there is some equipment that we have not received yet including the new swings and the ship was supposed to rock, we have been told by the manufacturer that as soon as the parts are in they will correct those issues. We believe the playground will be re-opened early next week.

City Manager, Marcos Nichols had an executive session request to consider confidential information related to marketing plans, specific business strategy, production techniques, trade secrets, or personal financial statements of an applicant for economic development assistance and to confer with the City attorney for legal advice. Vice Mayor Perry made a motion to go into executive session for the above mentioned reasons at 6:47pm followed by a second by Councilman Agee. Roll call was taken; 7 ayes, 0 nays, 0 absent. Vice Mayor Perry made a motion to come out of executive session and adjourn the Council work session at 7: pm, followed by a second by Councilman Agee. Roll call was taken; 7 ayes, 0 nays, 0 absent. The May 19th Council work session was adjourned.
