

# **MINUTES– PARKS BOARD**

**Regular Parks Board Meeting**

## **CALL TO ORDER:**

The meeting was called to order at 6:07 PM by Chairman Ryan Perry.

## **ROLL CALL:**

Present were: Mr. Perry, Ms. Hale, Ms. Haas, Ms. McIntosh and Ms. Cooney.

Motion to excuse Mr. Hill and Ms. Fry was made by Ms. Cooney and seconded by Ms. Hale. All were in favor.

## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

A motion to approve or amend the minutes of the May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Parks Board Meeting as submitted was approved by Ms. Hale and seconded by Ms. Hass. All were in favor.

## **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

Mr. Perry advised the board we will not be able to show the movie Sandlot at the June 12 Movies in the Park due to licensing issues. The board selected Angels in the Outfield to show in place of Sandlot. The motion was made by Ms. Hale and seconded by Ms. Haas, all agreed.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

The board invited Kinetic Recreation and Midstate Recreation to do a presentation on their Playground designs for Community Park. Dan Lanman with Kinetic Recreation presented a revised proposal. He presented two options to the board. Option 1 is a Pour in Place (PIP) surface and Option 2 is the Engineered Fiber Wood (EWF) surface, both have the same equipment. Much discussion was had. Molly Summerton with Midstate Recreation presented two options, as well. Option 1 with EWF (engineered wood fiber) surfacing and Option 2 with PIP (pour in place). Midstates proposal is the same proposal originally submitted. Again, there was much discussion. Mr. Perry asked the board to make a recommendation to Council. The board recommends Kinetic Receptions proposal #4481 pour in place for a not to exceed amount of \$236,000. Mr. Perry abstained from voting. The motion was made by Ms. Cooney and seconded by Ms. McIntosh. All were in favor.
